- Slaves' quarters and detached kitchen (ca. 1843) on site, originally built for an earlier home on this site and retained by Mr. Craft for the use of his slaves. In a preserved state and built of heavy-timber frame with batten-board siding.
- 2. Burton Place (1842) 248 S. Memphis Street Slaves' quarters and detached kitchen, built of brick masonry with three rooms en tandem; in a preserved state.



3. Magnolias (1852) - 305 Craft Street Slaves' quarters and detached kitchen are heavily rebuilt in modern interior/exterior renovations and further obscured by later built-over house extensions.


